2. To select photographs and information that are relevant to, and coherent with, the photo essay	2.1. The student has assessed the quality of given photographic techniques used.
	2.2. The student has identified the photo types that are used in photo-essays.
	2.3. The student has chosen information that is relevant to the photos to be included in the photo essay (and viceversa).
3.To create a photo-essay using the photos taken by themselves following the instructions on activity 21, using appropriate language and ICT techniques.	3.1. The student has used a photo-editing app and photo-sharing website to save images and publish the work
